### **Morning Sailing and Waterfront Adventure**

Morning sailing classes will be geared towards the following student groups:

- Children 7-12 new to sailing and/or still developing basic skills. These students will focus on the fundamentals of boat rigging and safe sailing close to shore. Depending on weather conditions, the class may also sail larger boats as a group or explore the waterfront on kayaks, paddleboards etc. This class will have a heavy dose of fun and games!
- More experienced sailors in the 10 to 13-year-old range with the ability to rig and launch boats independently and navigate safely around the harbor. These students will typically sail in most conditions, and instructor focus will be geared towards confidence navigating greater distances and refining boat handling as well as introductory racing concepts, depending on student interest. Students will also be exposed to a variety of boats and try different roles requiring teamwork.
- MBC's flexible lesson model can be tailored to the student experience level. Older children unable to attend afternoon classes are encouraged to speak with the Waterfront Director and Head Sailing Instructor about options for morning sailing. It is more than likely that older students can be integrated effectively into the morning lesson plans.

### **Afternoon Sailing Skills and Seamanship**

Afternoon sailing classes will be geared towards the following student groups:

- Children with strong fundamental sailing skills who seek additional growth in varied types of boats, learning seamanship as well as more advanced sailing/racing techniques. Depending on class ability, students may work as a group in larger boats or sail as a fleet in single-handed (Optis, Open Bics and Lasers) or double-handed (420s, RS Fevas) boats.
- Beginning and intermediate sailors typically 11 and up. MBC instructors can build lesson plans that focus on introductory sailing skills and building confidence navigating around MBC's waterfront. This group would pursue the same objectives as the morning class for new sailors but be geared towards slightly older children.
- As with the morning classes, families with schedule constraints, or whose children may be unsure of the best class fit, are welcome to speak with the Waterfront Director or Head Sailing Instructor to evaluate the attending the afternoon course, factoring in their child's age and experience.

Now, therefore, I do hereby agree as follows: 1) I consent to the participation of Child in Classes. 2) I (including heirs, successors and assigns) waive any claims against and releases any obligation of the Madison Beach Club (the "Club"), its employees, agents and or any other person acting in any capacity for the conduct of the Classes in relation to any loss, injury or damage, on land or at sea, to Child or property of mine to the fullest extent permitted by law. 3) I hereby authorize an instructor from the Club or Program, or an adult who bears this document, to authorize emergency treatment for the Child named above in the event that a parent or legal guardian cannot be reached at the above telephone numbers at the time of the emergency. 4) I hereby grant to the Club the right to use my child's name, age, and photograph, without compensation, in any press release, web site posting, advertisement, brochure or other medium intended to publicize the Classes or other Club activities. I have thoroughly read and understand the 2019 Waiver Agreement. By initialing this document, I acknowledge the execution of this agreement and agree to each of the provisions listed above.
